2017-2018 FACT SHEET

Through the generosity of our military and civilian communities, the Spangdahlem Spouse Organizations Scholarship Committee is able to give scholarships to outstanding graduating students.

SCHOLARSHIPS: There are two scholarships available. A) Scholarship for those that choose to enroll in a two-year associates degree program, trade or vocational school or B) Scholarship for those choosing to enroll in a four-year bachelor's degree program. Students will be required to indicate which scholarship they are applying for on the application.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be eligible for a SSOSC scholarship, a student must be a candidate for graduation with a 2.5 GPA from Spangdahlem High School, a host nation school, a school serving a GSU attached to Spangdahlem AB or a home-schooled student whose sponsor is assigned to the 52nd Fighter Wing. In addition, the Association reserves the right to reject any applicant who has a prior history of disciplinary problems or misconduct.

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP: Use of funds is limited to those accepted by an accredited university, community college, trade or vocational school. These funds may be used to help defray the cost of tuition, fees, and books. Scholarships must be used within 90 days or your check will expire, at which time undistributed funds revert back to the scholarship committee.

SELECTION: Recipients of scholarships will be selected by the Association's Scholarship Selection Committee. In selecting recipients, the Committee will consider the following:

SAT/ACT TESTING: Your SAT/ACT scores are important. If you have not already taken these tests, plan on taking them as soon as possible so that the results are included in your application. Results usually take 4-6 weeks. Contact your school counselors for SAT/ACT information.

APPLICATIONS: Applications are available through your school counselor or by contacting the scholarship committee at ssosc scholarships@gmail.com. Completed forms must be turned in **NO LATER THAN 1500, TUESDAY, 27 MAR 2018**. Check with your school counselor for information regarding the scholarship program.
